BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the proper administrative officials of the Parish of Bossier, State of Louisiana, be and they are hereby empowered, authorized, and directed to spread said taxes, as hereinabove set forth, upon the assessment roll of said Parish for the year 2021, and to make the collection of the taxes imposed for and on behalf of the taxing authority, according to law, and that the taxes herein levied shall become a permanent lien and privilege on all property subject to taxation as herein set forth, and collection thereof shall be enforceable in the manner provided by law.

MOTION was made by <u>STEPHANIE COLLIER</u> and seconded by <u>JASON MCGINTY</u> to approve and sign the Affidavit / Resolution 2021-001 after it was read in full by the board chairman. The Chairman called for public comment; there being none, vote was taken (<u>4 YEAS --- JOHNNY BARNETTE, STEPHANIE COLLIER, JAY VALENTINE, AND</u> JASON MCGINTY --- 0 NAYS --- 0 ABSTAINED --- 1 ABSENT --- SAMMY HALPHIN) and the motion carried unanimously.

BOND

Questions/Discussion about bond ---- Chief Turner informed the board of the need to obtain additional funds through a bond to pay for the station 3 addition and make necessary purchases such as apparatus, SCBA, computers, cardiac monitors, hydraulic tools, bunker gear, hose, and radio/loose equipment. The board was provided with information about the estimated cost of all of these purchases and a breakdown of the additional cost to tax payers based on the value of the property they own. Chief Turner informed the board that the total cost of all of the equipment and building addition would be approximately \$5,434,000.00. Obtaining an additional 2 mills would generate enough funds to pay for a 15-year bond in that amount. Chief Turner informed the board that around 90% of the total would be used for purchasing apparatus and SCBA. Chief Turner explained that the apparatus fleet is aging and that the current SCBA used by the department are no longer manufactured and will need to be replaced within the next 8 to 10 years. Chief Turner informed the board that Mark Waniewski will attend the May board meeting and explain the bond process. At that meeting the board can make a decision and vote to move forward in regards to obtaining additional funds with a bond.

APPROVE PERSNNEL ACTION FORMS

Questions/Discussion about PA forms: ----- The PA Forms were presented to the board for review during the meeting.

MOTION was made by <u>STEPHANIE COLLIER</u> and seconded by <u>JAY</u> <u>VALENTINE</u> to approve and for the chairman to sign the Internal/Civil Service PA forms. The Chairman called for public comment. There being none, vote was taken and the motion carried unanimously.
