### **UPDATE: STATION 3 CONSTRUCTION**

Chief Wallace reported that the district received the building plans, construction should start soon, and the price has decreased to just under \$1,100,000.00 for the new station 3 construction.

### **UPDATE: SCBA PURCHASE**

Chief Wallace reported that almost all of the new SCBAs have been received, the only equipment we are waiting on is delivery of some of the face masks. Once the face masks are received the new SCBAs will be put in service. Training on the new SCBAs has been completed with all fire department personnel.

### **UPDATE: FIRE PREVENTION BUREAU**

Chief Wallace reported that the Louisiana State Fire Marshals Office has recognized the district as having a Fire Prevention Bureau.

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## **NEW BUSINESS**

### SCBA – DECLARE SALVAGE

The board was presented with a list the current inventory of Honeywell SCBA to declare salvage once all of the new SCBA are in service. The Honeywell SCBA will be donated to neighboring fire districts who currently use the same type of SCBA.

### **DISCUSS 2023 BUDGET**

Chief Turner presented the board with a list of potential increases in 2023 budget. LWCC will likely increase when the payroll audit is done due to the extra pay period for the firefighters that occurred this year. The amount of the districts contributions to the pension fund will increase mainly due to the 2-mill tax increase. Medical insurance may increase four to six percent as it has done in previous years.
