GENERATOR FOR NEW BUILDING

Chief Wallace informed the board that the district will begin looking into the cost of installing a generator for station 3. The cost of the generator was removed from the bid to cut cost, the district can install it much cheaper than the contractor can.

STATION 4 WATER WELL

Chief Wallace informed the board that station 4 has no water supply at this time. In the past, the district shared a well with the land owner next to the station. Chief stated that the district needed to drill a well to supply the station with water. Chief estimated the cost of drilling the well to be around \$5,000.00. Chief stated that the district will get several quotes before any work is done.
