ADOPT RESOLUTION APROVING 2020 BUDGET

MOTION was made by <u>JAY VALENTINE</u> and seconded by <u>JOHN WHITTINGTON</u> to <u>approve Resolution No. 2019-008</u> relating to the adoption of the 2020 budget for the district. The Chairman called for public comment. There being none, vote was taken and the motion carried unanimously.

BE IT RESOLVED, the Benton Fire District # 4 budget for the year 2020 is declared adopted on December 10, 2019, by the Benton Fire District # 4 Board of Commissioners. A copy of the 2020 Budget is posted on the District website for viewing by the general public.

APPROVE CIVIL SERVICE/INTERNAL PERSONNEL ACTION FORMS

• Copies of all of the PA forms were provided for board members to review. Chief Turner informed the board that the majority of the PA forms were annual 2% raises for all employees with the exception of a few civil service PA forms to add/terminate extended sick leave and a substitute captain appointment.

MOTION was made by <u>STEPHANIE COLLIER</u> and seconded by <u>JOHN WHITTINGTON</u> to approve all Civil Service/Internal Personnel Action Forms. The Chairman called for public comment. There being none, vote was taken and the motion carried unanimously.

- Chief Turner informed the board that the District has received notification of a potential rate increase in July 2020 from the Firefighter Retirement System.
- Mark Waniewski stated that he attended a meeting with many Fire Chiefs from across the state on the rate increase. He stated that at this time they are trying to determine ways to get the rate down and more than likely the increase will occur next year.
